

## **Cultural Appropriation Policy Statement**

- 1. The Tofino Arts Council will not support arts programming that engages in cultural appropriation.
- 2. The Tofino Arts Council prioritizes programming by community members that reflects their own culture(s).

## Definitions:

Cultural appropriation is the deliberate or accidental borrowing from a culture that is not your own. This may include cultural practices or objects, music, stories, ceremonies or imagery.

The Canada Council for the Arts considers that "cultural appropriation" applies when:

cultural borrowings or adaptations from a minoritized culture reflect, reinforce or amplify inequalities, stereotypes and historically exploitative relationships that have direct negative consequences on equity-seeking communities in Canada.<sup>1</sup>
